





# 2011

## Season Review

In what turned out to be one of the toughest ever Division One leagues, our 2<sup>nd</sup> XI had to wait until 23<sup>rd</sup> of July for their first league victory.

The league only had 5 second teams in it with all the other teams being first elevens. Particularly strong were the clubs with ambition to return to the premier league. Clubs like Sedgfield were attempting to gain promotion to the top flight for the first time. Redcar, Saltburn, Thornaby and Blackhall were hoping to return to the premier league and had brought in new talent to help them achieve success.



With a mixture of experience and eager youth the opening games saw some good individual performances but these were not turned into victories. 16 year old Adam Baldwin (picture left) hit an unbeaten 65 in the season's opener with Guisborough and the experienced Garry Moody, Mark Stainsby and Colin Biglin all scored runs in the next three games. Unfortunately our bowling attack was not bowling sides out in these opening half a dozen games. We seemed to be drawing

against the second elevens and losing to the first elevens.

Once the exam season had ended our fortunes began to look up. We were fielding a more balanced and settled side. Jack Vickerman (pictured right) began to show how much he has developed as an opening batsman and produced scores against Blackhall and Sedgfield (88 and 76)



Jack really produced the goods however in our second win in July when he scored a maiden century (102) against Saltburn. With Tom Chapman and Dan Baldwin hitting form with the ball our performances were

becoming stronger each week. Tom took 7 for 29 in the victory over Middlesbrough and Dan had five fors against Saltburn and Sedgfield.

The form of wicket keeper, Andrew Sturgeon (pictured right) was consistent throughout the season and his position as one of the top two keepers in the league 1 stats shows this. He

represented the NYSD U 17 side in the Joe Lumb trophy which the NYSD won.

We then defeated Thornaby, the league leaders, with the Baldwin brothers stealing the show. Adam scored 48 and Dan Baldwin (pictured left) took 4 for 46 and at this point we were on target for becoming the highest placed second team in Division one.(an achievement which merits a trophy)

August ended with a poor performance at Seaton Carew, we were without Jack Vickerman and Tom Chapman whose heroics had earned them a place in the first eleven Short oif depth in batting only

Mark Stainsby (42) stayed around as we were finished on 133-9 . This was never enough and we lost by 5 wickets.

September began with an abandoned game against Redcar. They had amassed 256-6 when the heavens opened and brought an end to proceedings.

With two games left we were in 9<sup>th</sup> place and at the top Thornaby and Sedgfield were neck and neck but clear of the chasing pack and almost sure of promotion. We had to make



sure we gained as many points from the last two games to push our way up the table.

Paul Raines 8 for 29 at Yarm and Adam Baldwin's unbeaten 66 helped us demolish Yarm in our penultimate game

Garry Moody (pictured left) used his captaincy experience from over 20 years playing in the top flight to get the best from his side and he was ably assisted by vice captain Lee Craggs. The 2<sup>nd</sup> team used 28 players over the season in league games, 18 of whom were given the opportunity to bowl.
